

How to use the capsules with the inhaler

Only use the inhaler contained in this pack. Do not use the capsules with any other inhaler, and do not use this inhaler to take any other capsule medicine. Do not push the capsule through the foil to remove it from the blister. Capsules should always be stored in the blister and only removed immediately before use. With dry hands, remove capsule from the blister. Do not swallow the capsule. When you start a new pack, only use the new inhaler that is supplied in the pack. Each inhaler should be disposed of after 30 days of use. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines and inhalers no longer required. Do not swallow the capsules.

Using the inhaler



Pull off the cap.





Hold the base of the inhaler firmly and tilt mouthpiece. This opens the inhaler.






Separate one of the blisters, peeling away the protective backing expose the capsule. Place it into the capsule chamber. Never place a capsule directly into the mouthpiece.






Close the inhaler until you hear a "click".





Hold the inhaler upright mouthpiece with the pointing up. Pierce the capsule by firmly pressing together both side buttons at he same time. Do this only once.





Release the side buttons fully.





placing Before mouthpiece in your mouth, breathe out fully. Do not blow into the mouthpiece.



Hold inhaler the horizontally. Place the mouthpiece in your mouth and close your lips firmly around it.





Breathe in rapidly but steadily, as deeply as you ca. Do not press the side buttons. Note: as you breathe in through the inhaler, the capsule spins around in the chamber and you should hear a whirring noise.



Hold your breath for at least 5-10 seconds or as long as you comfortably can while taking the inhaler out of your mouth.



Then breathe out.


If you do not hear a whirring noise: the capsule may de stuck in the capsule chamber. If this happens: open the inhaler and carefully lossen the capsule by tapping the base of the inhaler. Do not press the side buttons. Repeat the steps: exhale, place the mouthpiece in the mouth and inhale.

Open the inhaler to see if any powder is still in the capsule. If any powder remains in the capsule, you should review the steps in the leafflet that comes with the device and/or seek for help with a health professional.

After use, open the inhaler, remove and discard the empty capsule in your household waste. Do not leave a used capsule in the chamber.

Close the inhaler and replace the cap.
